SBI to provide credit cards to farmers

To deepen the credit culture among the farming community of the country, its largest lender State Bank of India (SBI) will provide credit cards to the farmers through its subsidiary SBI Cards and Payments Services, said its Chairman Rajnish Kumar. He said the project had been taken up on a pilot basis in Gujarat, Rajasthan, and Madhya Pradesh, and then would be launched across the country depending on its success. Unlike the Kisan Credit Card, the SBI card would provide 40 days credit to farmers and the rate of interest charged would be normal as other SBI cards, Kumar said. **BS REPORTER**
